



[Gas Safe Register](#) is the official registration scheme in the United Kingdom, Isle of Man and Guernsey for installers and maintenance engineers dealing with gas appliances.



[NICEIC](#) is one of several providers given Government approval to offer Competent Person Schemes to oversee electrical work within the electrical industry.



[HETAS](#) are the official body recognised by Government to approve biomass and solid fuel domestic heating appliances, fuels and services, including the registration of competent installers and servicing businesses.



[The Water Industry Approved Plumbers' Scheme](#) (WIAPS) is funded by sixteen water suppliers in England and Wales, and operates an approved contractors' scheme on their behalf.



[Secure by Design](#) is the official UK Police flagship initiative combining the principals of 'designing out crime' with physical security.

[Cyfle Building Skills](#) is a New Regional Shared Apprenticeship Scheme.
